Instead I got into judgment collection because I was a landlord and I won a small claims judgment against a couple of my ex-tenants but they never paid me the money I won. I was frustrated and researched what the next steps were. I was successfully able to collect that first judgment using wage garnishments and Anoka County (MN) Sheriffs office who did the actual wage garnishment demand to my ex-tenants employer. I did my best writing this system, but some information could be old or even wrong, but this should help you get you started.*
